Detention Order

- having taken into account the Order to Forward Case for Investigation No.004/02, dated 20 February 2002 of the Military Prosecutor of the Military Court

after having interrogated the offender named **Kaing Khek Iev**, known as **Duch**,

order the detention of Kaing Khek Iev, known as **Duch**,
age 60, male, Khmer nationality, rank....., position former director of Tuol Sleng Prison (S-21), occupation: teacher and director of education in Samlaot District, Battambang, born in Peou Veuy Village, Peam Bang Commune, Stoeung District, Kampong Thom Province;
current residence O Tuntim Village, Ta Saing Commune; Samlaot District, Battambang Province;
father's name Kaing Ky, deceased; mother's name Meas Kim Sieu, 79 years;
wife's name Chhem Sophal, deceased
having 4 children;
previous conviction political detention, arrested 10 May 1999

for crimes against humanity, according to Article 5 and 39 of the Law on the Establishment of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia for the Prosecution of Crimes Committed during the Period of Democratic Kampuchea, dated 10 August 2001

committed in Cambodia during the period from 17 April 1975 to 6 January 1979

The Prison Director/Military Prosecutor has the obligation to discharge this Order effectively
