after having interrogated the offender named **Ung Choeun**, known as **Ta Mok**, in order to **guarantee a good investigation**

**order the detention of Ung Choeun**, known as **Ta Mok**, age 75 years, male, Khmer nationality, rank....., position Leader of the Khmer Rouge, occupation....., born in Prakeap Village, Chieng Tong Commune, Tram Kok District, Takeo Province; current residence Pteah Kandal (Choam), on the Cambodia-Thai border; father's name Ung Preak, deceased; mother's name Uk Soch, deceased; wife's name Vy Pon, aged 43 years; having 6 children; previous conviction....., arrested 6 March 1999

for crimes against humanity, according to Article 5 and 39 of the Law on the Establishment of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia for the Prosecution of Crimes Committed during the Period of Democratic Kampuchea, dated 10 August 2001

committed in Cambodia during the period from 17 April 1975 to 6 January 1979

The Prison Director/Military Prosecutor has the obligation to discharge this Order effectively
